IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

RESOLVE, for Laying the County Taxes for the Year Nineteen Hundred and Nineteen.

WHEREAS, the appropriations called for in this resolve are immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health and safety, and in the opinion of this legislature constitute an emergency as contemplated by the constitution, be it therefore

Resolved: That the sum annexed to the counties in the 2 following schedule is hereby granted as a tax on each coun-3 ty respectively to be appropriated, assessed, collected and 4 applied to the purpose of paying the debts and necessary 5 expenses of the same and for other purpose of law, for the 6 year nineteen hundred nineteen:
