#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT Repealing Provisions of Law Relating to Paving and Construction of Streets and Highways and Removal of Snow Therefrom by Street Railroad Companies and Conferring Jurisdiction upon the Public Utilities Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. All laws of this state imposing upon street *2* railroad companies assessments or requirements as to pay3 ing for paving or construction or reconstruction of streets
4 and highways and the removal of snow therefrom, or por5 tions thereof and all provisions of the charters of any
6 such corporations imposing such burdens are hereby re7 pealed.

#### SENATE—No. 208.

Sect. 2. The Public Utilities Commission shall have au-2 thority to impose upon street railway companies operat-3 ing in the state of Maine such assessments for or such 4 proportions of the cost of paving, constructing or recon-5 structing streets and highways or portions thereof and 6 the removal of snow therefrom, over or upon which their 7 tracks run, as after due public hearing it shall deem proper. 8 The Public Utilities Commission in its orders or decrees 9 assessing or imposing any such burdens shall determine 10 the amount of the same and the method of payment thereof.
