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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND  
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

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AN ACT to Amend Section Sixteen of Chapter One Hundred Eighteen of the Revised Statutes, Increasing the Registration Fees of Dealers in Securities and their Agents or Salesmen.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section sixteen of chapter one hundred eighteen of the  
2 revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out, in the first  
3 line thereof, the words "for his services" and by inserting  
4 after the word "registration" in the fourteenth and seven-  
5 tenth lines thereof, the words 'or renewal of registration'  
6 and by striking out the word "five" in said seventeenth line  
7 and inserting in place thereof, the word 'ten,' and by strik-  
8 ing out, in the nineteenth line thereof, the words "for  
9 renewal of registration, five dollars," so that said section  
10 as amended shall read as follows:

Sect. 16. The bank commissioner shall receive:

For a certificate of authorization of a loan and building  
2 association, five dollars, in advance.

For each license authorizing a foreign banking corporation  
2 to conduct its business in this state, and each renewal thereof,  
3 twenty dollars.

For receiving service of process against such corporation,  
2 or against a foreign corporation acting as trustee of a mort-  
3 gage given by a domestic corporation, two dollars, which shall  
4 be paid by the plaintiff at the time of such service, and shall  
5 be recovered by him as a part of his taxable costs, if he pre-  
6 vails in the suit.

For granting license to foreign corporations selling securi-  
2 ties on the partial payment or instalment plan, and for each  
3 renewal thereof, twenty dollars.

For registration, or renewal of registration, of dealers in  
2 securities, twenty-five dollars, which shall be returned if  
3 application is not granted.

For certified copies of dealer's certificate, fifty cents each.

For registration, or renewal of registration, of salesman or  
2 agent of dealer in securities, ten dollars each.'
