STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Amend Section One of Chapter Three Hundred and Nineteen of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Fifteen, as Amended by Chapter Three Hundred and Four of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Seventeen, Entitled "An Act to Provide for State and County Aid in the Construction of Highway Bridges."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one of chapter three hundred and nineteen of 2 the public laws of nineteen hundred and fifteen, as amended

- 3 by chapter three hundred and four of the public laws of
- 4 nineteen hundred and seventeen, is hereby further amended
- 5 by changing the period at the end of said section one to a

6 semicolon and adding the following: 'when the tax rate 7 determined as above is ten mills and less than twenty mills 8 the cost of the bridge shall be borne as follows: Fortyo five per centum by the town, city or unorganized town-10 ship, thirty per centum by the county and twenty-five per II centum by the state; when the tax rate determined as above 12 is twenty mills and less than thirty mills the cost of the 13 bridge shall be borne as follows: Forty per centum by 14 the town, city or unorganized township, thirty per centum 15 by the county and thirty per centum by the state; when 16 the tax rate determined as above is thirty mills and less 17 than forty mills the cost of the bridge shall be borne as 18 follows: Thirty-five per centum by the town, city or un-19 organized township, thirty per centum by the county and 20 thirty-five per centum by the state; when the tax rate de-21 termined as above is forty mills or over the town's share 22 of the cost of the bridge shall be reduced five per centum 23 for each ten mills or fraction thereof in excess of forty 24 mills, and the state's share of the said cost shall be in-25 creased in the same ratio; provided that in no event shall 26 the town's share of the cost of any bridge constructed or 27 reconstructed under this act be less than twenty per centum 28 of the cost of said work.' So that said section one as 29 amended shall read as follows:

'Section 1. When public convenience and necessity re-2 quire the building or rebuilding of any bridge in any town or 3 city or unorganized township, said bridge being located

4 on any main thoroughfare, and the cost of said construc-5 tion, together with all other moneys raised for the con-6 struction and repair of ways, highways and bridges in said 7 town, city or unorganized township makes a tax rate in 8 excess of five mills on the valuation of the town, city or o unorganized township last made by the board of state as-10 sessors, the cost of the construction of said bridge shall 11 be borne as follows: Fifty per cent. by the town, city or 12 unorganized township, thirty per cent. by the county in 13 which said town, city or unorganized township is located 14 and twenty per cent. by the state; when the tax rate de-15 termined as above is ten mills and less than twenty mills 16 the cost of the bridge shall be borne as follows: Forty-17 five per centum by the town, city or unorganized town-18 ship, thirty per centum by the county and twenty-five per 19 centum by the state; when the tax rate determined as 20 above is twenty mills and less than thirty mills the cost 21 of the bridge shall be borne as follows: Forty per centum 22 by the town, city or unorganized township, thirty per 23 centum by the county and thirty per centum by the state; 24 when the tax rate determined as above is thirty mills and 25 less than forty mills the cost of the bridge shall be borne 26 as follows: Thirty-five per centum by the town, city or 27 unorganized township, thirty per centum by the county 28 and thirty-five per centum by the state; when the tax rate 29 determined as above is forty mills or over the town's share 30 of the cost of the bridge shall be reduced five per centum 31 for each ten mills or fraction thereof in excess of forty
32 mills, and the state's share of the said cost shall be in33 creased in the same ratio; provided that in no event shall
34 the town's share of the cost of any bridge constructed or
35 reconstructed under this act be less than twenty per centum
36 of the cost of said work.
