# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Several State Normal Schools and the Madawaska Training School for Permanent Repairs and Improvement of Buildings.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in 2 favor of the several state normal schools and the Mada-3 waska Training School the sum of twelve thousand five 4 hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred nineteen, 5 and the sum of twelve thousand five hundred dollars for 6 the year nineteen hundred twenty, said sums to be expended 7 under the direction of the board of trustees of state normal 8 schools as indicated in the following schedule.
