STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

- AN ACT to Amend Section Thirty-two of Chapter One Hundred and Seventeen of the Revised Statutes as Amended by Chapter One Hundred and Eighty Three, Public Laws of One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventeen, Relating to the Salaries of the Board of State Assessors and for Clerk Hire in Said Office.
- Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section thirty-two of chapter one hundred seventeen of the 2 revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out the word 3 "fifteen" in the fifth line and substituting the word 'two-4 thousand,' so that said section as amended shall read as 5 follows:

SENATE-No. 239.

'Sec. 32. Each member of the board of state assessors 2 shall receive an annual salary of two thousand dollars; they 3 shall also receive their actual expenses incurred in the per-4 formance of their official duties. The clerk of the board 5 of state assessors shall receive an annual salary of two-6 thousand dollars.'
