STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT in Relation to Appropriations for the Maine State
Library.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section sixteen of chapter three of the revised statutes is
2 hereby amended by striking out in the first and second lines
3 of said section the words "two thousand dollars shall be
4 biennially appropriated for," and by inserting in place there-
5 of the words 'the legislature shall from time to time ap-
6 propriate sums for the maintenance and increase of'; so
7 that as amended said section shall read as follows:

'Sect. 16. Appropriation. R. S. c. 3, sect. 16. The legis-
2 lature shall from time to time appropriate sums for the
3 maintenance and increase of the library, to be expended in
4 purchasing or otherwise procuring books, maps, charts and
5 works, as are deemed most useful, and in binding and keep-
6 ing in good condition the works therein.'
