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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND

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AN ACT Authorizing the Appointment of a State Pension  
Agent.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section five of chapter one hundred and forty-eight of  
2 the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding after  
3 the word "council," in the third line of said section, the  
4 words, 'who may appoint a state pension agent'; also by  
5 adding at the end of said section the following words: 'The  
6 state pension agent may employ one or more clerks with  
7 the approval of the governor and council, as the business

8 of his office may demand'; so that as amended said section  
9 shall read as follows:

'Sect. 5. Certificates, by whom to be issued. R. S. c.  
2 145, section 5. The execution of the first eight sections of  
3 this chapter devolves upon the governor and council, who  
4 may appoint a state pension agent, who shall regulate the  
5 proof required to entitle applicants to the benefit thereof,  
6 and shall issue certificates therefor. The state pension agent  
7 may employ one or more clerks with the approval of the  
8 governor and council, as the business of his office may de-  
9 mand.'
