STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Amend Chapter Two Hundred Fifteen of Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Seventeen to Provide for Payment of a Bounty on Bears Killed in the State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section five of chapter two hundred fifteen of the public

laws of nineteen hundred seventeen is hereby amended by

adding to said section the following words: 'and so much

of the fees received for dog licenses as may be necessary

to pay said bounties, is hereby appropriated to pay the

6 same'; so that as amended said section shall read as fol-7 lows:

'Sect. 5. Bounties to be paid from dog licenses. The boun2 ty so paid by the state treasurer shall be taken from the
3 fees received from the licenses of dogs, in the State of
4 Maine, and so much of the fees received for dog licenses as
5 may be necessary to pay said bounties, is hereby appro6 priated to pay the same.'
