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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND  
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

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AN ACT to Increase the Amount Allowed for Clerk Hire to  
the Lewiston Municipal Court.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter 444 of the private and special laws of 1907 as  
2 amended by chapter 20 of the private and special laws of  
3 1915, is hereby amended by striking out the words "six  
4 hundred and fifty" in the third line of said section, and  
5 inserting in place thereof the words, 'seven hundred and  
6 eighty,' so that said section as amended shall read as fol-  
7 lows:

'Section 1. The clerk of the municipal court of the city of  
2 Lewiston shall receive an annual salary of twelve hundred

3 dollars, with seven hundred and eighty dollars additional  
4 for clerk hire from said city in quarterly payments, which  
5 said sums shall be in full compensation for the perform-  
6 ance of all duties required of said clerk by law. He shall  
7 account quarterly under oath, to wit, on the first days of  
8 January, April, July and October of each year, to the treas-  
9 urer of the city of Lewiston for all fees received by him or  
10 payable to him by virtue of his office, specifying the items,  
11 and shall pay the whole amount of the same to the treas-  
12 urer of the city of Lewiston quarterly on the days afore-  
13 said.'
