IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND  
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Appropriate Moneys for the Expenditures of the  
Government for the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred  
and Twenty.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

In order to provide for the several acts and resolves of  
2 the legislature requiring the payment of money from the  
3 State treasury, and also to provide in part for the neces-  
4 sary expenditures of government for the current fiscal  
5 year one thousand nine hundred and twenty, the following  
6 sums are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the  
7 state treasury, and, except where otherwise specially pro-  
8 vided, the governor with the advice and consent of the  
9 council is hereby authorized at any time prior to the first

10 day of July, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-one,  
11 to draw his warrant on the state treasurer for the same.
