STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT Relating to the Term of Service of the City Treasurer and Collector of the City of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The treasurer and collector of the city of
2 Portland shall be elected by the city council, and shall
3 hold office for the term of three years. The present treasurer
4 urer and collector of the city of Portland shall continue
5 in office for a term of three years from the second Monday
6 day of December, 1918.

Sect. 2. Vacancies occurring in said office shall be filled
2 by the city council for the unexpired term.

Sect. 3. All acts, parts of acts, and ordinances of the city
2 of Portland, inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.
