STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Provide a Bonus for the Heads of State
Departments.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

All heads of state departments, or members of state boards
2 and commissions who receive yearly salaries fixed by law
3 and whose salaries have not been increased directly or
4 indirectly by the seventy-ninth legislature shall be paid for
5 each of the years nineteen hundred and nineteen and nine-
6 teen hundred and twenty an annual bonus as follows: upon
7 salaries of two thousand dollars or less a bonus of thirty-
8 three and one-third per cent; upon salaries in excess of
9 two thousand dollars and not more than twenty-five hun-

10 dred dollars, a bonus of thirty per cent; upon salaries in
11 excess of twenty-five hundred dollars and not more than
12 three thousand dollars, a bonus of twenty-five per cent;
13 upon salaries in excess of three thousand dollars and not
14 more than thirty-five hundred dollars, a bonus of twenty
15 per cent; upon salaries in excess of thirty-five hundred
16 dollars and not more than four thousand dollars, a bonus
17 of fifteen per cent; and upon salaries in excess of four
18 thousand dollars a bonus of ten per cent. All such bonuses
19 shall be paid from any unexpended balance of any appro-
20 priation made for such departments, boards or commis-
21 sions or from the state contingent fund.
