STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Amend Section Fifty-one of Chapter Thirty-three of the Revised Statutes, as Amended by Chapter Two Hundred and Nineteen of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Seventeen and by Chapter One Hundred and Ninety-six of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Nineteen, Relating to the Trapping of Foxes in Lincoln County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

So much of section fifty-one of chapter thirty-three of 2 the revised statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred 3 nineteen of the public laws of nineteen seventeen and by 4 chapter one hundred ninety-six of the public laws of nine-5 teen nineteen, as prohibits the trapping of foxes in Lincoln
