STATE OF MAINE

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

**AN ACT to Regulate Clerk Hire in the Offices of Registers of
Probate.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The total sums to be allowed for the payment of clerk hire
2 in the offices of registers of probate in the several counties
3 shall be as follows:

Androscoggin, fifteen hundred dollars.

Aroostook, fifteen hundred dollars.

Cumberland, three thousand dollars.

Franklin, seven hundred eighty dollars.

Hancock, nine hundred dollars.

Kennebec, seventeen hundred dollars.

Knox, nine hundred dollars.

Lincoln, six hundred twenty-four dollars.

Oxford, twelve hundred dollars.

Penobscot, two thousand dollars.

Piscataquis, six hundred twenty-four dollars.

Sagadahoc, nine hundred dollars.

Somerset, nine hundred dollars.

Waldo, seven hundred eighty dollars.

Washington, nine hundred dollars.

York, two thousand dollars.

The following paragraphs of section forty-five of chapter
2 one hundred seventeen of the Revised Statutes as amended
3 by the Public Laws of 1917 and 1919 are hereby amended
4 so as to conform to the compensations as hereinbefore
5 provided:

Paragraphs two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight, nine, ten,
2 eleven, twelve, thirteen, fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, and
3 seventeen.
