STATE OF MAINE

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

AN ACT to Regulate Salaries of Registers of Probate.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section thirty-nine of chapter one hundred seventeen of the
2 revised statutes as amended by chapter one hundred sixty-
3 seven of the public laws of 1917 and by chapter two hundred
4 fourteen of the public laws of 1919 is hereby amended so as
5 to read as follows:

'Sect. 39. Registers of Probate in the several counties shall
2 receive annual salaries from the treasuries of the counties
3 to be paid in equal monthly installments on the last day of
4 each month, as follows:

Androscoggin, two thousand dollars.
Aroostook, twenty-two hundred dollars.
Cumberland, twenty-five hundred dollars.
Franklin, fifteen hundred dollars.
Hancock, eighteen hundred dollars.
Kennebec, twenty-two hundred dollars.
Knox, eighteen hundred dollars.
Lincoln, twelve hundred dollars.
Oxford, two thousand dollars.
Penobscot, twenty-two hundred dollars.
Piscataquis, twelve hundred dollars.
Sagadahoc, fifteen hundred dollars.
Somerset, eighteen hundred dollars.
Waldo, fifteen hundred dollars.
Washington, fifteen hundred dollars.
York, twenty-two hundred dollars.

The sums above mentioned shall be in full compensation for
2 the performance of all duties required of Registers of
3 Probate.'
