STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Amend Chapter One Hundred and Sixteen of the
Private and Special Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Fifteen
Relating to Court House in Town of Rumford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section six of chapter one hundred and sixteen of the pri-
2 vate and special laws of nineteen hundred and fifteen is
3 hereby amended so that it shall read as follows:

'Sect. 6. The purpose of this act is to enable the county
2 commissioners of the county of Oxford to carry out the
3 provision of chapter forty-seven of the public laws of nine-
4 teen hundred seven for the care of the term of the supreme
5 judicial court therein authorized to be held at Rumford

6 and to provide more adequate accommodations for said
7 supreme judicial court for the Rumford Falls municipal
8 court and the probate court at all sessions of said courts
9 required to be held at Rumford and for all other purposes
10 herein expressed. And said county shall have the use of
11 such portions of the building as are intended for the accom-
12 modation of said county free of rental, but the cost of re-
13 pair, maintenance and care of said building shall be divided
14 between the town of Rumford and the County of Oxford,
15 the former paying two-thirds of such charges and expense
16 and the latter one-third.'
