STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Amend Chapter Ten, Section One, of the Revised Statutes, Relating to Poll-tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Chapter ten, section one of the revised statutes, is hereby
2 amended by striking out all of the fifth line of said section
3 and inserting in place thereof the words 'be five dollars,'
4 so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Section I. A poll-tax shall be assessed upon every male 2 inhabitant of the state above the age of twenty-one years 3 whether a citizen of the United States or an alien, in the 4 manner provided by law, unless he is exempted therefrom 5 by this chapter, which said poll-tax shall be five dollars.'
