STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT Fixing the Term of Office of the Treasurer and
Collector of the City of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The treasurer and collector of the city of Portland shall be elected by the city council and shall hold office for a term of five years, subject, however, after a hearing, to removal for good cause, by concurrent vote passed in each branch of the city council of the city of Portland, by the assent of two-thirds of all the members thereof. The present treasurer and collector shall continue in office under the provisions of this act for a term of five years from the

9 time this act takes effect, subject, however, to the provisions
10 of this act in respect to being removed for cause.

Sect. 2. Vacancies occurring in said office from any cause
2 shall be filled by the city council for the unexpired term.
3 This act shall not take effect unless adopted by two-thirds
4 vote of all the members of the city council of the city of
5 Portland at a special meeting thereof duly called and held
6 for that purpose.

Sect. 3. All acts and parts inconsistent herewith are here-
2 by repealed.
