STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT Granting to J. Fred Sawyer of Greenville, Piscataquis County, Maine, so Much of the Bed of Moosehead Lake as Is Necessary for the Support of His Building in Said Greenville.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

J. Fred Sawyer of Greenville in the county of Piscataquis 2 in the State of Maine, his heirs and assigns forever, are 3 authorized to erect and maintain a building thirty-six feet 4 in width on West street in the village of said Greenville, 5 and forty-five feet in length, extending northerly from the 6 north line of said West street, which building is situated 7 in part over the waters of said Moosehead Lake, and sup-8 ported from the bed of said lake substantially as said build-9 ing is now situated, it being a few feet westerly from the 10 building now occupied as the Greenville post office.
