STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Amend Section Three of Chapter Ninety-nine of the Private and Special Laws of 1915, Creating the Office of Corporation Counsel of the City of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section three of chapter ninety-nine of the private and

- 2 special laws of nineteen hundred fifteen is hereby amended
- 3 so that as amended said section shall read as follows:

'Sect. 3. Said corporation counsel shall be furnished a

- 2 suitable office in the city hall. He shall give his entire
- 3 time, during the hours when other offices in said city hall
- 4 are open for the transaction of the city's business on secular
- 5 days, to the duties of his office, and shall receive such sal-

6 ary as the city counsel shall determine, but said salary 7 shall be not less than twenty-five hundred dollars per an-8 num, payable in twelve equal monthly installments, together 9 with an allowance for clerk hire, the amount to be fixed by 10 the city counsel.'
