STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT Authorizing the Maine General Hospital to Increase Number of Directors to Twenty-four.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The Maine General Hospital at an annual meeting of the 2 corporation is hereby authorized, if it shall so determine, to 3 increase the number of directors from twelve to twenty-4 four.

If the corporation shall decide to increase the number of 2 its directors as aforesaid, it shall at the same annual meet-3 ing elect eight directors, two of them to hold office for the 4 term of one year, two of them to hold office for the term 5 of two years, two of them to hold office for the term of 6 three years and two of them to hold office for the term of

7 four years. Thereafterwards annually four directors shall 8 be chosen by the corporation for the term of four years.

Otherwise the provisions of existing law remain un2 changed, except that when such increase in the number of
3 its directors has been made by the hospital, the visitors
4 shall appoint two additional directors to hold office for
5 the term of four years and at the expiration of the term
6 of any director appointed by the visitors, they shall an7 nually appoint two persons to be directors for four years,
8 so that the number of directors appointed by the visitors
9 shall be eight with terms corresponding to the terms of
10 the directors chosen by the corporation.
