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**STATE OF MAINE**

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**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND  
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

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AN ACT Additional to and Amendatory of Chapter Twenty of the Private and Special Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Seventeen, Relating to the Operation of Eggmoggin Reach Ferry in Hancock County.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter twenty of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and seventeen is hereby amended by adding after section four the following sections:

‘Sect. 5. Said Charles H. Scott, his associates and assigns shall be subject to all the conditions, regulations and requirements of sections three, four, seven and eight of chapter twenty-seven of the revised statutes.

Sect. 6. The county commissioners of Hancock county  
2 shall have authority, on due notice and hearing of all par-  
3 ties interested, to prescribe such rules and regulations,  
4 touching the maintenance and operation of said ferry not  
5 otherwise provided in nor inconsistent with sections one,  
6 two, three and four of said chapter twenty, as they may  
7 deem necessary to meet the public demand in connection  
8 therewith.'
