AN ACT to Repeal Chapter Eighty-four of the Private and Special Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Nineteen, Entitled "An Act to Provide for the Building of Public Wharves and for the Establishment of Adequate Port Facilities and for the Advancement of Commerce", Known as the Portland Pier Act.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter eighty-four of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and nineteen, entitled "An Act to Provide for the Building of Public Wharves and for the Establishment of Adequate Port Facilities and for the Advancement of Commerce", known as the Portland Pier Act, is hereby repealed.
