STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Permit the Town of Southport to Obtain a Supply of Pure Water.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The rights, powers and privileges of Southport which were 2 originally granted by chapter one hundred and twenty-nine 3 of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and 4 fifteen, and which were further extended for periods of 5 two years respectively by chapter seventy-seven of the pri-6 vate and special laws of nineteen hundred and seventeen 7 and chapter thirty-one of the private and special laws of 8 nineteen hundred and nineteen, are hereby extended for a 9 period of two years from the time this act shall take effect 10 and the town of Southport shall have all the rights, powers 11 and privileges that were granted by said chapter one hun-12 dred and twenty-nine to be exercised in the same manner 13 and for the purposes therein specified.

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
