STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Northern Oxford Fish and Game
Association.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the
2 sum of one thousand dollars for the purpose of making re-
3 pairs and improvements on fish hatchery of the Northern
4 Oxford Fish and Game Association, and erecting a camp for
5 the keeper of said hatchery.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Northern Oxford Fish and Game Association, composed of fish and game enthusiasts in and around the headwaters of the Androscoggin river in the region above Sawyer lake in Oxford county, constructed in the fall of 1920 a fish hatchery, and with the assistance of the federal authorities, the bureau of fisheries at Washington, have planted from two hundred and fifty thousand to three hundred thousand eggs of the finest quality, and are now employing a caretaker at their own expense. This hatchery is located in the midst of the best fishing grounds of the state, and the assistance is asked because the proposition involves the expense of a caretaker and has got beyond the resources of the association.
