**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

AN ACT to Extend the Charter of the Quebec Extension
Railway Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Quebec Extension Railway Company, which were granted by chapter forty-one of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, and extended by chapter fifty-six of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and fifteen, and extended by chapter fifteen of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and seventeen, and extended by chapter six of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and nineteen, are hereby continued in force and extended for two years from the time this act

11 goes into effect, and all the rights, powers, privileges and
12 franchises which were granted, or have been acquired by
13 virtue of said act, may, and shall be, exercised in the same
14 manner and for the same purpose as provided in said chap-
15 ter forty-one.

Sect. 2. Nothing herein contained is intended to repeal
2 or shall be construed as repealing the whole or any part of
3 any existing statute, and all the rights and duties herein
4 mentioned shall be exercised and performed in accordance
5 with all the applicable provisions of chapter fifty-five of the
6 revised statutes, and acts amendatory thereof or additional
7 thereto.
