STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Amend Chapter One Hundred and Thirty-four of the Public Laws of One Thousand Nine Hundred and Nineteen, Relating to Fishing in Kennebago Stream, in the County of Franklin and in the County of Oxford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

So much of chapter one hundred and thirty-four of the 2 public laws of one thousand nine hundred and nineteen as 3 prohibits a person from fishing in the ordinary way of

- 4 angling with artificial flies or fly fishing, and taking one
- 5 fish in one day, during the open season provided by the
- 6 general law of the state, from the big falls on Kennebago
- 7 stream to the outlet of said stream at Indian Rock, which

8 stream is located in the county of Franklin and in the coun-9 ty of Oxford, is hereby repealed.
