STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Amend Section Eight, Chapter Thirteen of Revised Statutes Relating to County Law Libraries.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section eight of chapter thirteen of the revised statutes is
2 hereby amended by adding in the sixth line after the word
3 "dollars" the words 'The treasurer of Aroostook county
4 shall pay annually to law library association of said county
5 the sum of five hundred dollars, in addition to the five hun6 dred dollars above mentioned, and at least five hundred
7 dollars shall be expended annually by the library associa8 tion of said county for books for the library at the court

9 house at Caribou in said county;' so that said section as 10 amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 8. Payments to county law libraries, R. S. c 12, 10. 2 1905, c 157. The treasurer of each county, except the coun-3 ty of Lincoln, shall annually pay to the treasurer of the 4 law library association of his county, for the uses and bene-5 fits of the county law library, the sum of five hundred dol-6 lars. The treasurer of the county of Lincoln shall annually 7 pay to the treasurer of the law library association of his 8 county, the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars. The 9 treasurer of Aroostook county shall pay annually to law 10 library association of said county the sum of five hundred 11 dollars, in addition to the five hundred dollars above men-12 tioned, and at least five hundred dollars shall be expended 13 annually by the library association of said county for books 14 for the library at the court house at Caribou in said county. 15 The treasurer of each county shall also pay to the treasurer 16 of the law library association of his county all money re-17 ceived from persons admitted as attorneys in the supreme 18 judicial court upon motion, without a certificate from the 19 board of examiners of applicants for admission to the bar.'
