STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to License Moving of Motor Vehicles to Make Repairs Thereto.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Any person engaged in the business of carrying on a motor
vehic'e service station or repair shop may make application
under oath to the commissioner of motor vehicles for a spetial license to move and operate any unregistered motor
vehicle or trai'er, not his own, to and from any service station or repair shop for the purpose of making repairs or
performing other labor on said vehicle, and delivering it to
its owner. The commissioner may grant the application if
satisfied of the facts therein stated and upon payment of

10 a fee of ten dollars issue to the applicant an annual license
11 containing the name and business address of the licensee,
12 together with one set of number plates of a distinguishing
13 color or design. Such plates when conspicuously attached
14 to each end of any such vehicle shall authorize its operation
15 by any licensed operator of motor vehicles over ways and
16 bridges for the purposes herein specified.
