STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Provide for the Purity of Ice Cream and Sherbert Offered for Sale.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

No person, firm or corporation shall manufacture, have

- 2 in possession for sale, sell or offer for sale, or otherwise
- 3 dispose of, ice cream or sherbert which contains any un-
- 4 pasteurized milk or cream.

Whoever violates any provision of this Act shall be pun-2 ished for each offense by fine not exceeding fifty dollars.
