STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Provide for Return and Cleansing of Ice Cream and Sherbert Containers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Every person, firm or corporation who shall purchase 2 for the purpose of resale, ice cream, sherbert or water ice

- 3 in cans or other vessels which are to remain the property
- 4 of the party from whom such purchase is made, shall with-
- 5 in twenty-four hours after emptying said container cause
- 6 the same to be thoroughly cleansed and returned to the
- 7 manufacturer or dealer from or through whom it was pur-
- 8 chased, or to the carrier which made the delivery.

Whoever violates any provision of this Act shall be pun-2 ished for each offense by fine not exceeding fifty dollars.
