IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Land Agent to Sell Public Lot Eighty-five in Moro Plantation, Aroostook County.

Resolved: That the land agent is hereby authorized to 2 sell and convey to actual settlers thereon certain lands in 3 Moro Plantation, in Aroostook county, lot number eighty-4 five, constituting part of the school lots of said plantation, 5 if he deems such sales advisable, for such price per acre 6 and on such terms of payment as he may deem advantage-7 ous; provided, that in making sales of said lands the legal 8 and equitable rights of persons claiming under said settlers 9 shall be considered and preserved; and provided, also, that 10 the proceeds of any sales made shall be added to the school 11 funds of said plantation.
