STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Amend Section Three and Section Five of Chapter Two Hundred and Three of the Private and Special Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Thirteen, Entitled "An Act to Incorporate the Ogunquit Village Corporation."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section three of chapter two hundred and three
2 of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and
3 thirteen is hereby amended by striking out the words, in
4 lines eighteen, nineteen and twenty, "Said village corpora-
5 tion shall annually pay to the town of Wells the sum of
6 seven hundred dollars to be used by said town in mainte-

7 nance of its high school," so that said section three, as
8 amended, shall read as follows :

'Sect. 3. The town of Wells is hereby relieved from any
2 and all duty to build, repair or maintain roads, streets or
3 ways, within the territory of said Ogunquit Village Corpora-
4 tion. But if at any time said roads, streets, ways or bridges
5 within the territory of said village corporation shall become
6 unsafe and inconvenient for public travel, the selectmen of
7 said town may repair same so that they shall be safe and
8 convenient and the expense of the same borne by said vil-
9 lage corporation and shall be retained by said town of Wells
10 out of the moneys hereinafter provided to be paid said cor-
11 poration. With reference to the common schools which
12 are within the territory of said corporation there shall be
13 paid to the town of Wells by this corporation whatever
14 amount is the actual net cost to said town of Wells for
15 maintaining said common schools and schoolhouses, located
16 within the limits of said corporation, reference being had
17 to the amount raised therefor by taxation and the amount
18 which said town of Wells receives from the state of Maine
19 for the maintenance of common schools.'

Sect. 2. Section five of said chapter two hundred and
2 three is hereby amended by inserting therein after the words
3 "exclusive of the state and county tax" in line five, the
4 words, 'and whatever sums appropriated and raised by taxa-
5 tion to pay the general government expenses of said town
6 and the expenses to the town of its high school and what-
7 ever appropriations made and raised by taxation towards

8 payment of the town's indebtedness, or interest thereon, in-
9 sofar as the said corporation has benefited by such indebt-
10 edness,' so that said section five, as amended, shall read as
11 follows :

'Sect. 5. The town of Wells shall pay over to the treas-
2 urer of said corporation out of the taxes collected from the
3 inhabitants and the estates within the territory of the Ogun-
4 quit Village Corporation aforesaid, a sum equal to sixty
5 per centum of all the town taxes, exclusive of the state and
6 county tax and whatever sums appropriated and raised by
7 taxation to pay the general government expenses of said
8 town, and the expenses to the town of its high school and
9 whatever appropriations made and raised by taxation
10 towards payment of the town's indebtedness, or interest
11 thereon, insofar as the said corporation has benefited by
12 such indebtedness, collected from said inhabitants and es-
13 tates. Said sixty per centum shall be payable to said treas-
14 urer as follows, viz. : one-quarter of said amount on or be-
15 fore May fifteen of each year, one-quarter of said amount
16 on or before July fifteen of each year, and the balance on or
17 before December fifteen of each year. The amount of such
18 sixty per centum in any year shall be determined by com-
19 puting said sixty per centum upon the amount of money
20 raised by taxation and appropriation upon the property with-
21 in said Ogunquit Village Corporation the year previous.'
