**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND

AN ACT Granting to County Commissioners Authority to
Regulate Clerk Hire in County Offices.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The county commissioners of the several counties shall
2 have the authority at all times, to re-adjust the allowances
3 for clerk hire in the various offices of their respective coun-
4 ties as the needs of said offices may require; provided, how-
5 ever, that nothing in this act shall preclude the fixing by
6 legislative enactment of a proper amount to be allowed for
7 clerk hire in any county office in cases where the county
8 commissioners refuse to grant an adequate allowance.
