STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Catching of Smelts in the Piscataqua River.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

No person shall use seines or nets of any description to

- 2 catch smelts in the Piscataqua river or its tributaries; pro-
- 3 vided, however, that nothing in this act shall forbid anyone
- 4 from maintaining a weir to catch smelts for his own per-
- 5 sonal use.
