STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Amend and Enlarge the Corporate Powers of the Fort Kent Electric Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The Fort Kent Electric Company, a corpora
tion now authorized to generate, make, sell, distribute and

supply electricity in the towns of Fort Kent and Eagle Lake

in the county of Aroostook and in the Plantations of Walla
grass, St. John, St. Francis, and Allagash, is hereby author
ized to purchase, sell, distribute, and supply electricity for

all purposes in the towns of Frenchville, St. Agatha, Mada
waska and Grand Isle in said county of Aroostook, and

the said corporation is hereby authorized to construct lines

10 for the transmission of electricity through the town of Van 11 Buren, from the feed lines of the Gould Electric Com12 pany at Van Buren, and to transmit electricity for the pur13 poses of this act through the said town of Van Buren, to 14 be sold and distributed by the said Fort Kent Electric Com15 pany.

Sect. 2. It shall be unlawful for said corporation to trans-2 mit electric current, generated within this state, for sale or 3 use beyond the limits of this state.

Sect. 3. Nothing herein contained is intended to repeal 2 or shall be construed as repealing the whole or any part of 3 any existing statute. And all the rights and duties herein 4 mentioned shall be exercised and performed in accordance 5 with all the applicable provisions of chapter fifty-five of the 6 revised statutes.
