AN ACT to Authorize the Town of Rangeley to Acquire the Wharves in Rangeley Lake of the Rangeley Lakes Steamboat Company.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The town of Rangeley, in the county of Franklin, is hereby  
2 authorized and empowered to purchase, and the Rangeley  
3 Lakes Steamboat Company, a corporation duly established  
4 and existing under the laws of the state, is hereby author-  
5 ized to sell and convey to said town of Rangeley, the  
6 wharves, together with all the rights and privileges con-  
7 nected therewith, owned by said company, and situate in  
8 Rangeley lake in said town of Rangeley, described as fol-  
9 lows: The wharf commencing at the southerly end of Lake

10 street in Rangeley village in said town of Rangeley and  
11 extending into the waters of said Rangeley lake; also the  
12 wharf, near the foot of Rangeley lake in the town of Range-  
13 ley aforesaid, commencing at the end of the road leading  
14 from Haines landing to Rangeley Outlet wharf and extend-  
15 ing into the waters of said lake.

Said town of Rangeley, by its municipal officers, when  
2 duly authorized by a vote of the inhabitants of said town,  
3 and said Rangeley Lakes Steamboat Company are hereby  
4 authorized and empowered to enter into a mutual written  
5 agreement for the purchase and sale of said property upon  
6 such terms as may be agreed upon by said town and said  
7 company.
