STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Protect the Water Supply of the Town of East
Livermore.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No person shall at any time in the year fish
2 in the waters of Moose Hill pond in the town of East Liver-
3 more in the county of Androscoggin.

Sect. 2. Any person violating section one of this act shall
2 be punished by a fine of not less than ten dollars nor more
3 than twenty dollars and costs for each offense.

Sect. 3. Municipal courts and trial justices shall have
2 jurisdiction on each offense under this law.
