**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

AN ACT to Amend Section Two of Chapter Fifty-one of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Nineteen Relating to the Training of Rural Teachers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section two of chapter fifty-one of the public laws of nineteen hundred nineteen is hereby amended by striking out all of the last sentence in said section and substituting therefor the following words: 'The governor and council shall direct the payment of such amounts as they shall approve out of the appropriation for the training of rural teachers and said amounts shall be deducted from state school funds,' and said section when amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 2. The state superintendent of public schools is

2 hereby authorized to arrange for the payment of necessary
3 expenses of travel and board incurred by teachers in at-
4 tending said school of instruction, and at the close of the
5 school year he shall recommend to the governor and coun-
6 cil, upon satisfactory evidence of successful service, the pay-
7 ment to each teacher so trained of a bonus of twenty-five
8 per cent. of the annual salary paid to her by the town for
9 her services. The governor and council shall direct the
10 payment of such amounts as they shall approve out of the
11 appropriation for the training of rural teachers and said
12 amounts shall be deducted from state school funds.'
