## STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Michael Burns.

Resolved: That Michael Burns be authorized to bring 2 suit at common law in the supreme judicial court against 3 the State of Maine for damages claimed to have been sus-4 tained by him on account of a criminal prosecution begun 5 in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-seven; and, if it 6 appears that such prosecution was begun and carried on 7 by the order of the executive, that said Burns shall have 8 the same right to maintain suit against the state and to re-9 cover damages that he would have against an individual for 10 the same prosecution where the action is not barred by the 11 statute of limitations.

### HOUSE--No. 226

Any damages that may be recovered in such suit shall be 2 payable from the state treasury out of any moneys not 3 otherwise appropriated.
