**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

AN ACT to Legalize the Granting of Certain Fish Weir Li-
censes in Tide Waters of What Was Formerly Muscle Ridge
Plantation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The acts of the board of selectmen of the town of South
2 Thomaston in issuing certain fish weir licenses to Wm. Un-
3 derwood Company, lessee, and to Charles E. Rackliff in
4 tide waters of what was formerly Muscle Ridge Plantation,
5 to wit, the Andrews Island and Pond Island privileges is-
6 sued the first day of April A. D. nineteen hundred and
7 eighteen, and the Flag Island privilege issued on the twenty-
8 second day of May A. D. nineteen hundred and eighteen,
9 are all hereby ratified, confirmed and made valid.
