STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Amend Section Four of Chapter One Hundred Sixty-seven of the Private and Special Laws of Nineteen Hundred Seven, Incorporating the Allagash Improvement Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. Section four of chapter one hundred sixty2 seven of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred
3 seven is hereby amended by substituting for the word "ten"
4 in the seventh line of said section the word 'fifteen,' and
5 by substituting for the word "twenty" in the ninth line of
6 said section the word 'thirty,' so that said section as amended
7 shall read as follows:

Said company may demand and receive tolls 2 for passage of all logs and lumber over their dams and im-3 provements and for the passage of all logs and lumber be-4 tween the said dams and improvements and the mouth of 5 said Aliagash river as follows: For all logs and lumber 6 coming into said river between Allagash falls, so-called, and 7 the mouth of the Allagash river and driven thereon after 8 June first of each year fifteen cents per thousand feet; and o for all logs and lumber passing over said Allagash falls, 10 thirty cents per thousand feet. All the above tolls shall II be reckoned on the number of feet, board measure, woods 12 or stumpage scale. Said Allagash, Improvement Company 13 shall have a lien upon all logs and lumber which may so 14 pass over its dams and improvements or down said Alla-15 gash river below its said dams and improvements until the 16 full amount of toll is paid, but the logs of each particular 17 mark shall only be holden to pay the toll on such mark. 18 If said toll is not paid within thirty days after such logs 19 or lumber, or the major part thereof, shall have arrived 20 within the limits of the Madawaska Log Driving Company, 21 the said Allagash Improvement Company may seize, hold 22 and sell at public auction such part of said logs or lumber 23 as shall be necessary to pay such tolls, with all incidental 24 charges and costs thereon, after ten days' notice in writing 25 of the time and place of said sale given to the owner of 26 such logs or lumber. Said corporation may also proceed 27 to collect its dues for toll by action at law or, if necessary,28 by suit in equity.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect January first, nineteen 2 hundred twenty-two.
