STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Amend Chapter Two Hundred and Eighteen of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Seventeen, Providing for the Establishment of a Bureau of Markets.

Pe it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter two hundred and eighteen of the public laws of 2 nineteen hundred and seventeen is hereby amended by strik-
