STATE OF MAINE

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

AN ACT to Amend Chapter Two Hundred and Eighteen of
the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Seventeen, Pro-
viding for the Establishment of a Bureau of Markets.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter two hundred and eighteen of the public laws of
2 nineteen hundred and seventeen is hereby amended by strik-
3 ing out the whole of said section and inserting in place there-
4 of the following:

“The commissioner of agriculture is hereby authorized and
2 directed, through such agents as he may appoint for the
3 purpose, and in co-operation with such agricultural corpora-
4 tions or associations as he deems proper, to investigate the

5 existing methods and costs of marketing farm products and
6 purchasing farm supplies, and to secure improvement there-
7 in.'
