**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

AN ACT to Authorize the Town of Sanford to Raise and
Expend Money to Erect a Memorial to Its Soldiers and Sailors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The town of Sanford in the county of York is hereby au-
2 thorized to raise and expend a sum of money not exceeding
3 \$20,000.00 for the purpose of erecting and establishing a
4 memorial to the soldiers and sailors from the town of San-
5 ford and that the same may be raised by taxation or other-
6 wise.
