## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Amend the Charter and Change the Name of Portland Realty Association.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Powers and purposes enlarged. Portland Real2 ty Association, a corporation organized under the general
3 law of Maine on the fifteenth day of March, in the year
4 one thousand nine hundred and thirteen, the purposes of
5 which are defined in its certificate of organization, is hereby
6 authorized to add to the purposes for which the corporation
7 exists the following, viz: to buy, sell and deal in mortgages
8 of personal property, notes and other certificates of indebted9 ness secured or unsecured, and to loan money thereon.

- Sect. 2. Shall be under control of bank commissioner.
- 2 Said corporation shall be subject to such rules and regula-
- 3 tions as may be prescribed by the banking commissioner in
- 4 the conduct of its business in the loaning and use of moneys.
- Sect. 3. Name changed. The name of said corporation 2 is changed to Portland Mutual Loan Association.
- Sect. 4. Approval of stockholders necessary. Before this 2 act shall take effect it shall be accepted by vote of the stock-3 holders representing a majority of the outstanding stock of 4 said corporation passed at a meeting to be held for the pur-5 pose. Within thirty days from the passage of such vote a 6 copy thereof, certified by the clerk of the corporation, shall 7 be filed in the office of the secretary of state, who shall re-
- 8 cord such copy in the book wherein certificates of organiza-
- 9 tion of corporations organized under the general law are 10 recorded.
