STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT Amending Section Three of Chapter Three Hundred Seventy of the Special Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Nine Relating to Police Department of the City of Portland, Defining Rank of Lieutenants.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section three of chapter three hundred seventy of the spe2 cial laws of nineteen hundred and nine relating to police
3 department of the city of Portland is hereby amended by
4 striking out said section and inserting the following:

'Sect. 3. The city council of the city of Portland may 2 by ordinance classify policemen, in the manner following:

First Grade. Inspectors who shall rank as lieutenants. Second Grade. Sergeants.

Third Grade. Patrolmen.

No person shall be appointed to the grade inspector or ser-2 geant unless he shall be a regular officer of the police force.'
