IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Milo.

Resolved: That there be appropriated for the purpose of 2 reimbursement to the town of Milo for aid to mothers with 3 dependent children during the year nineteen hundred and 4 nineteen, the sum of eighteen (\$18) dollars.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The town of Milo paid Mrs. Charlotte Cochrane aid as a mother with dependent children to the amount of thirty-six (\$36) dollars during the year 1919. The town is entitled to reimbursement of one-half this amount by the state, but failed to file its claim until after the appropriation for 1919 had lapsed. Legislative authority is necessary in order for the town to obtain the money from the state.
