STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT Limiting the Salaries and Fees of Certain City and Town Officers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

No city, town, plantation, village corporation, district,

- 2 school board, or other subordinate public body charged with
- 3 the expenditure of public moneys shall pay to any officer,
- 4 agent or employee as salary or fees a sum of money which
- 5 (including any sum paid to such officer, agent or employee
- 6 by the state or any department thereof) shall be in excess
- 7 of four thousand dollars per annum.
